Professor David E. Sturrock

David Sturrock is Professor of Political Science at Southwest Minnesota State University. His specialties include state and local government, American national government, political parties and elections, and comparative politics. He involves his students in the real world of politics through attendance at precinct caucuses, organizing candidate debates, and designing and carrying out exit polls on Election Day.

Professor Sturrock has more than 30 years of experience in politics and government in six states. Highlights include holding local office in New York and Minnesota, service on numerous local and state boards, lobbying for local issues in Saint Paul and Washington, campaign manager, candidate, and party official. He has attended six national party conventions, was his party's nominee for presidential elector in 2008, and is currently Secretary-Treasurer of the Minnesota Republican Party.
